Scholarships in the amount of \$3,000 will be awarded to 2024 TILLAMOOK HIGH SCHOOL graduates

These scholarships may be used for a:

- *4-year College or University
- *Community College
- *Technical or Vocational school (accredited degree)

****NOTE**:** Summer Term Requirements: Scholarships will be awarded after October 1st once a full term has been completed and after receiving evidence that the student attended and successfully completed the schools minimum requirements for full-time student classification of attendance.

Fall Term Requirements remain the same accept scholarships will be awarded after January 1st. Payments may be delayed if required information is not received by March 30th. Official grade transcripts must be received by March 30th of the following year of the award otherwise the scholarship funds may be rescinded.

TO QUALIFY, APPLICANT MUST:

1. ... Be a 2024 graduate of Tillamook High School
2. ... Have a minimum high school GPA of 2.75
3. ... Enter chosen school no later than the first available term immediately following high school graduation
4. ... Submit application information as outlined on page 2
5. ... **Sign and date** your Letter of Application to the Committee or it will be rejected

Complete and return your Letter of Application and all required information directly to the Tillamook High School Resource Center on or before Friday, April 5, 2024. Please do NOT mail it to the Committee - Final applicants may be asked for a personal interview. The THS Alumni Scholarship Fund, Inc. is non-commercial, non-sectarian, non-partisan, and shall not discriminate against any person because of sex, race, age, religion or disability.

TO APPLY (Read Carefully)

1. The first page of your **Letter of Application** must be typed, containing the following information:

- Name, home address, phone number and e-mail address.
- Parents or Guardian names, occupations, and names of their employers.
- Names and ages of siblings, whether or not they live at home. If sibling(s) attend college, please indicate.
- List any other people living in your household, but not listed above.
- **Sign and date your Letter of Application**

****NOTE*****If the above information is not included, your application will be disqualified.*

2. In addition, please provide the following:

- Letter of Recommendation from a teacher, counselor, administrator, or community leader.
- Official transcript of your high school grades.
- Letter of Application to the Selection Committee including:
 - a) High school activities in which you participated
 - b) Work experience, if any, during high school
 - c) Other activities such as clubs, community service, volunteer work
 - d) Name of the college you plan to attend
 - e) Your educational and career goals
 - f) How you plan to finance your college education
 - g) List scholarships and grants (with amounts) you've received to this point
 - h) **Your Letter of Application to the Selection Committee must have your signature and date otherwise the application will be disqualified.**

3. Please complete and return your application directly to the THS Counseling Department. If at all possible please include a current photo of yourself. **Do not mail it to the Committee.**

It is important that your Letter of Application be typed and that you address each of the above topics. If you hand-write your application letter or omit any of the above information, your application will not be considered. All information in this application is strictly confidential.
